Dear Riders, Trainers, Grooms, Team Members,

It is a great pleasure to welcome all of you at Nagykanizsa Horse Trials, the most prestigious annual international three-day event of Hungary.

To spend a really good time here we would like to give you some basic information about the program and local regulations.

Stables Daily Schedule

(from Thursday 30th June till Sunday 3rd July)

Opening: 05.30

Closing: 22.00

Entrance at the stables off operating hours will be recorded.

Training Schedule

Training areas (Practice area, Lunging & Grazing area, Canter area) are open from 7 AM till 9 PM daily.

Obstacles are placed on Practice area. For galloping please use the designated Canter area.

Further schedule will be posted at the info-boards.

Any request for changes on the training schedule must be submitted at the Show Office.

Attention! The published program is subject to change. Any changes in the timetable will be posted at the info-boards.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Stables and Security

Never loose your horse! The horses mustn't move on the showground without wearing their head-numbers from 14.00 Thursday till Sunday evening.

We kindly ask all riders, grooms and officials to wear their wristbands during the entire event. Wristbands can be taken during the registration.

It is strictly forbidden to smoke in the stable area. Smoking is penalized by € 50.

It is not allowed to step in the area of the stables between 22.00 and 5.30. If it is necessary for any reason, the security-guard has to note the names and the reason of the entrance.

Restricted areas

Entering the cross-country course is not allowed before the opening of the course (Friday, 1st July). Please do not enter the organisational areas (show office, control center, etc.)

Vet Check

Please lead the horses for horse inspections on bridle by the published starting order. Please show up 10 minutes before indicated time to avoid program shifts.

Riding

Riding for practice reasons in the competition areas is not allowed. Only the designated areas (ie. Practice area, Lunging & Grazing area, Canter area) can be used for training.

Lunging of horses is allowed only in the separated lunging area or in the cantering area.

The training areas are open by the published timetable (see on info boards).

Please, always follow the instructions of the stewards on duty. It is not allowed to leave the area or ride further than it is possible to be seen by the stewards.

We kindly ask you to work with the non-competing horses possibly not during the time of the competitions.

Show Office, Starting lists, Result sheets, Protocols

The starting lists, the result sheets and the protocols will be available at the show office.

It is not allowed to enter the show office. Colleagues will help you at the info box.

All necessary information will be posted on the info boards at the show office and near the stable area.

Straw, Shavings, Hay, Manure

Straw: Included in the box-fee. It will be available at the entrances of the stables.

Shavings: Please ask the stable manager. (stable manager - Ms. BÁNKUTI DOBRI Noémi)

Hay: Not available on the showground.

Manure: You have to put the manure to the designated areas at the ends the stables.

Farrier: Mr. GEDŐVÁRI Ferenc is available daily from 8 AM till 7 PM, for the expense of rider.

Entering, Payments, Hours of business

Please, make your settlement at the show office.

It is possible to pay with EURO.

We are not able to accept credit cards. You can find cash-machines at the supermarkets in Nagykanizsa or at the bank offices.

Latest payment before start of dressage, not later than Friday noon.

Business hours: Thursday 14:00 – 20:00

Friday 08:00 – 12:00

Please, observe the above declared opening hours and regulations in order to avoid disqualification.

Restaurant

Open: from Thursday noon, daily from 7:00 till 23.00.

Restaurant provides snacks and full dishes all day long. Breakfast, lunch and dinner can be ordered for teams and individuals by special requests.

The bar provides soft beverages and alcoholic drinks.

It is possible to pay with EURO in the restaurant and shops at the showground.

Shops

Vendor pavilions (equestrian shop, hand-workers) are open on Saturday and Sunday.

Saturday evening program

Rider' night – Sat. 21:00 in Beer Tent

The aim of the party is to greet the riders after XC phase, to weld together the nations participating at the event, and basically to get known each other. Teams may offer their own dishes to others.

Restaurant stays open after closing hour, according to interest for consumption.

Photo slide show and video presentation is possible during the evening.

Parking

Unloading: at the designated areas (signed with 6 on the map).

Lorries: in the main parking lot (2) or in lorry parking lot (8).

Riders' cars: riders are allowed to park their cars in the camping site, but no traffic is allowed after Friday morning. For those who want to move their cars during the event, we suggest to use the car park reserved for riders (7) (near the old hotel).

Should you have any technical problem with your car during the event, please do not hesitate to contact our colleagues for a car repair assistance.

Safety

Please take care of your possessions. Never leave your car open. Never leave valuable equipments without control. The OC does not take any responsibility for thefts occurred in stable, parking or camping areas.

Please keep an eye on the others. Riders, team members, and staff of the OC wear wristbands. Only people with valid wristband are allowed to enter the stable and lorry parking areas, and the camping. If you see somebody without wristbands in the mentioned areas, please inform the closest steward or security guard.

The OC makes great effort to ensure optimal and safe circumstances for all horses, riders and spectators. However, the OC doesn't take any responsibility for the horses entered to the event, or for any damage they may cause.
